**NOTICE OF APPEAL**

**TAKE NOTICE THAT:**

1. Wayne Nogier, the above named Appellant, hereby appeals to the Council of the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics (the Council) from the decisions of the Discipline Committee finding the Appellant guilty of professional misconduct and sentencing him accordingly. The dates of the decisions are March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 and August 4th, 2011.
2. The source of the Appellant's right of appeal and Council's jurisdiction to entertain the appeal is section 36 of *The Paramedics Act* (the Act).
3. The appeal is taken on the following grounds:
  - (a) The evidence regarding count # 5 of the charges against the Appellant did not and/or could not constitute professional misconduct under section 25 of the Act.
  - (b) The Discipline Committee erred in finding that the phone call(s) to the complainant were, in proper context, bullying or intimidation.
  - (c) Such other grounds as the Appellant may argue.

4. The Appellant requests that the finding of guilt be quashed and an acquittal entered. In the alternative, the Appellant submits that the appropriate penalty was a simple reprimand.
