## **PRIMARY CARE PARAMEDIC BRIDGE**

**Tuition: \$ 750**

The Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) Bridge course will offer the CMA accredited, Saskatchewan trained or Saskatchewan licensed EMT the opportunity to attain the credentials of a Primary Care Paramedic.

The PCP Bridge course will focus on the new knowledge and skills of the Primary Care Paramedic program while recognizing the prior learning experience as an EMT. The introduction of the PCP program is a requirement of all Canadian EMS Training Institutions to ensure they remain compliant and current with the National Occupational Competency Profiles and maintain accreditation with the Canadian Medical Association Accreditation Services.

**NOTE: The PCP Bridge course consists of a 6 week home study component (in which students will be introduced to a Web based learning environment which includes participation in online discussions and activities) followed by 3 on campus weekends.**

## **PRIMARY CARE PARAMEDIC RE-ENTRY**

**Tuition: \$ 870**

The Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) Re-entry course will provide the opportunity to prepare for or to maintain the Saskatchewan; College of Paramedics licensing credentials of a CMA accredited Primary Care Paramedic for the province of Saskatchewan.

The course will focus on the new knowledge and skills of the Saskatchewan licensed Primary Care Paramedic while also reviewing and evaluating the fundamental level of practice. The PCP Re-entry course ensures the non active or non EMS PCP's remain compliant and current with the National Occupational Competency Profiles and Saskatchewan scope of practice as defined by the Saskatchewan Emergency Treatment Protocols.

**NOTE: The PCP Re-entry course consists of a 6 week home study component (in which students will be introduced to a web based learning environment which includes participation in on line discussions and activities) followed by 3 weekends of classroom instruction, lab demonstrations and evaluation.**

**This course replaces the former EMT Refresher course previously offered at SIAST and does not include certification or recertification in ITLS or CPR/AED.**

## **INTERNATIONAL TRAUMA LIFE SUPPORT (ITLS) - Provider**

**Tuition: \$ 385**

You will develop the skills you need to recognize mechanisms of injury, assess, perform critical interventions, and package and transport the trauma patient. The workshop's primary purpose is to provide you with the fundamental knowledge and experience necessary to get the trauma patient to the emergency department in the best possible condition. You will focus on identifying conditions that require immediate transport (load and go conditions) in order to save the patient.

## **INTERNATIONAL TRAUMA LIFE SUPPORT (ITLS) – Refresher**

**Tuition: \$ 210**

ITLS Providers who want to maintain current certification must take this workshop. You will review key theory and the patient assessment format. The pre-workshop material includes an ITLS post-test (to be completed prior to the workshop start date). The workshop is seven hours long (one day) and concludes with a scenario evaluation. Your ITLS refresher certificate is valid for three years. You will receive an updated ITLS Provider wallet card upon successfully completing the workshop.

## ADVANCED CARE PARAMEDIC RE-ENTRY (EMER 1625)

The Advanced Care Paramedic (ACP) Re-entry course will provide the CMA accredited EMT- P/ ACP graduate an opportunity to prepare for the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics licensing requirements of an Emergency Medical Technician – Paramedic (EMT-P) or Advanced Care Paramedic (ACP) for the Province of Saskatchewan. The ACP Re-entry course will focus on the new knowledge and scope of practice skills or procedures of the Saskatchewan licensed EMT-P / ACP while also reviewing and evaluating the fundamental level of practice. The introduction of the ACP Re-entry Course in 2009 is a barrier limited learning opportunity that enables the recent ( less than 5 years) non active practitioner the ability to re-enter EMS by demonstrating compliance with the National Occupational Competency Profiles and Saskatchewan scope of practice as defined by the Saskatchewan Emergency Treatment Protocols. The ACP Re-entry course does not include certification or recertification in ITLS, ACLS or PALS. The ACLS, PAL'S and ITLS courses are available at SIAST through the Continuing Education Department. You must be current in CPR C, ACLS, PALS, ITLS.

## PEDIATRIC ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT (PALS)

As a health care professional who has responsibility for the well-being of infants and children, you will learn systematic approach in resuscitating infants and children. The workshop is offered to Physicians, Registered Nurses, Respiratory Therapists or Advanced Care Paramedics who have received CPR Basic Life Support “C” certification within the last two years.
