



Primary Care Paramedic Bridge and Re-Entry – EMER1642

The Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) Bridge/Re-entry course will provide the recent (less than 5 years) non active PCP trained practitioner the opportunity to re-renter the EMS workforce and prepare for or maintain the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics licensing requirements and the Saskatchewan trained or Saskatchewan licensed EMT practitioner training to qualify for Saskatchewan College of Paramedics PCP 2011 NOCP licensure. The course will focus on refreshing prior learning and introducing new scope of practice skills and procedures that align to the scope of practice as defined by the Saskatchewan Emergency Treatment Protocols. Evaluation of the fundamental level of knowledge and skills will be assessed through written and performance exams.

The course consists of a 6 week web based home study component followed by **four** weekends of classroom instruction, lab demonstration and evaluation. An official transcript will be awarded upon successful completion of the course.

An EMS practicum is required. The hospital/ambulance practicum will require completion of approximately 132 hours. Additional practicum time may be required for the participant to demonstrate academic progress and a competent level of practise.

The course does not include certification or recertification in ITLS or CPR.
