



Primary Care Paramedic Upgrader (EMER 1638)

The Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) Upgrader Course will offer the CMA accredited, Saskatchewan Licensed paramedic the opportunity to upgrade their credentials to the 2011 National Occupational Competency Profile (NOCP) for paramedics. The course requires completion on an on-line component followed by four full days of on-campus lab sessions. An in-hospital practicum is required in which participants will be required to successfully initiate a required number of intravenous cannulations and safely administer medications within scope of practice.
