Salary: Pay ranges from \$27.20/hr to \$33.90/hr in accordance with the IAFF Local 3270 Collective Agreement (2017).

Duties of Position: This work involves clinical care and safe transportation of individuals, including emergency and non-emergency responses as well as inter-facility transfers.

Clinical expectations and responsibilities for Primary Care Paramedics are based on the current National Occupational Competency Profile (NOCP) for Primary Care Paramedics, the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics registration requirements as well as Medavie Health Services West policies, procedures and protocols.

Paramedics are also expected to maintain and operate ambulances and related equipment in accordance with patient needs and public safety.

Required Qualifications and Other Job Requirements:

- Primary Care Paramedic program/course of over six months;
- Must meet all legislated requirements for Paramedics in Saskatchewan;
- Must be currently registered with the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics;
- Must have a valid Saskatchewan Class 4 Driver's Licence (or equivalent);
- Must submit ITLS, CPR C for Health Care Providers, and PEPP certifications;
- Must submit a valid and clean criminal record check;
- Must submit a current driver's abstract;
- Must demonstrate the ability to work efficiently as a member of the team and possess strong interpersonal skills;
- Must be able to work all shifts as assigned, maintaining a good attendance record;
- Must have a high regard for confidentiality; and
- Must have excellent work habits and have a professional appearance.
