#### **GENERAL ACCOUNTABILITY**

Reporting to the Director of Primary Health Care, the incumbent will be required to function as an ACP in a multi-disciplinary setting both in facility and in community. The ACP will collaborate with the RN to provide assessment and treatment to ill and injured patients presenting to the Emergency Room. The ACP will provide support to Acute Care and Long Term Care transport clients between home and airport and/or Health Clinic. The ACP will perform all assigned duties in a safe and productive manner.

#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Function as a full scope Advanced Care Paramedic in the hospital and community setting
- Be available as an ALS intercept for Road Ambulance
- Provide support to Home Care and Palliative Care – function in a Community Paramedicine role
- Ensure employee/client/patient confidentiality at all times
- Must be able to work with little supervision; must be self-directed
- Perform other duties, as required
