

Carnduff EMS looking for a PCP .7fte as below

.7 fte CCA/PCP detail: 26 hours/week or 52 hours/2 weeks or 104 hrs/4 weeks or 1365 hours/year

Works out to approx. \$52,000/yr

Calculation is as follows

$$\begin{aligned} & 1365 \times 21.61 = \$29,500 \\ & +(\$5.00/\text{hr on call} \times 16 \text{ hrs} \times 170 \text{ days/yr}) = \$13,650 \\ & +(6 \text{ hrs/wk ems call time} \times \$28.09/\text{hr} \times 52 \text{ wks} = 8,764 \\ & \text{TOTAL} = \$ 51,914 \end{aligned}$$

This is conservative figure and does not including over time, stat pay, shift diff. etc.

It is at Step 1, there are no union dues.

Other benefits are pension, medical, dental, sick, bereavement.

These are prorated based on the fte you work at.

Call Volume approx. 1 call every 3 days ranging from 3 to 10 hours/call

A normal day consists of a day shift at the Sunset Person Care Home working as a Special Care Aide starting at 0650 and going 1400 at which time you go to the ambulance base and complete any ambulance related duties until 1500.

You carry a portable radio 24 hours a day that you are on shift

You can usually supplement your income by getting on casual at Oxbow just 15 minutes down the road if this is not enough time for you. Oxbow also has a larger call volume but are unionized and work evenings hours as well.
