Reporting to the Director of Primary Health Care, the incumbent will be required to function as a PCP in a multi-disciplinary setting in ambulance, clinic, and community. The PCP will collaborate with the RN to provide assessment and treatment to ill and injured patients presenting to the clinic. The PCP will perform all assigned duties in a safe and productive manner.

- Function as a full scope Primary Care Paramedic in the ambulance, clinic, and community setting
- Provide support to Home Care and Palliative Care – function in a Community Paramedicine role
- Ensure employee/client/patient confidentiality at all times
- Must be able to work with little supervision; must be self-directed
- Perform other duties, as required

- Graduate of a CMA accredited Primary Care Paramedic program
- Unrestricted License from the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics as an Primary Care Paramedic
- Valid Class 4 Drivers License
- Current CPR – HCP, ITLS / PHTLS
- Current CTAS Training or willing to obtain within 6 months of hire
- CAMATA Course Preferred or willing to obtain within 6 months of hire
- Ability to fly in small aircraft in all circumstances
- Community Paramedicine Training is an asset
- Emergency Planning Training is considered an asset
- Physically fit to perform duties
- Clear Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Search
