

## **Emergency Medical Services-Regina 2020 Spring Recruitment Process**

### **Permanent Full Time ACPs and Casual PCPs Closing date- February 28, 2020**

Candidates will only be contacted if they meet these eligibility requirements:

- Completed CMA accredited program.
- Currently licensed or be eligible for licensure with the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics. ([www.collegeofparamedics.sk.ca](http://www.collegeofparamedics.sk.ca)).

An air brake endorsement will be considered an asset.

Candidates may be invited to participate in our comprehensive recruitment process where you will be required to demonstrate your knowledge and technical skills. Regina EMS values of compassion, respect, stewardship, and collaboration will be addressed in an interview, ride-a-longs and the reference checks. The final recruitment stage is passing physical testing to ensure you are capable of performing in a high call volume service.

Yearly call volume in Regina is approximately 23,000 calls including about 6,000 inter-facility transfers. RQHR EMS provides a range of paramedical services to the residents of Regina and surrounding area. In addition to traditional calls, Regina EMS supports the staffing efforts for Community Paramedics to Primary Health Care and relief staff to the Addictions Treatment Centre.

Successful recruitment candidates will be provided extensive classroom orientation and field training under the supervision of a Field Trainer. Regina EMS provides continuing education and professional development opportunities throughout an employee's career.
